Junior Domestic Competition Representative Player Points Policy

1. Purpose

This policy is designed to ensure fairness and balance in KBA Junior Competitions by regulating the number of high-level representative players permitted in a team. It encourages long-term player development within clubs while preventing the formation of dominant teams.

2. Player Points Allocation

 Each player is allocated points based on their most recent VJL season as per the table below:

Player Level	Points
VC (Victorian Championship)	4 points
VJL 1	3 points
VJL 2-3	2 points
VJL 4-5	1 point
VJL 6 & Lower / No Rep	0 points

3. Team Points Cap & Seasonal Adjustments

- If a player's most recent VJL season was in a younger age group than their domestic team, they receive a one-point deduction from their previous classification. Example: If a player's last VJL season was from U14s VC level (four points), but they are playing U16s domestically, they will receive a one-point discount.
- Total team points must not exceed 10.
- This cap applies at the start of the season and teams must remain at or below 10 points throughout.
- If a player does not make a representative team before the beginning of the Winter domestic season, they retain the points from their last confirmed VJL season.
- Players who are not currently playing representative basketball but have in the past will lose one point **per year** from their last representative season.

4. Loyalty Discounts

- Players who have been with the same domestic club for two years (four seasons) or more will receive a discount of one-point. This applies to a player once per club tenure.
- Loyalty discounts do not apply to fill-in players.
- A player may receive only one discount (either seasonal adjustment or loyalty, not both).

5. Fill-In Player Rules

- Fill-in players must be sourced as per the fill-in policy.
- Fill-in players must not cause the team to exceed 10 points. Example: If the remaining players equate to eight points, the fill-in must be two points or lower.
- Fill-in players do not qualify for any discounts.

6. Enforcement & Consequences

- Teams exceeding the allowed points cap must adjust their roster before the season starts.
- All KBA Junior Domestic Competition By-Laws representative player-related rules remain in place and must be adhered to.
- Mid-season adjustments due to representative promotions will be reviewed at the beginning of the next season.
- Teams found intentionally misrepresenting player experience will face penalties, including possible disqualification from the competition.
